FOOD BOOTH: Registered clubs with an honor booth would be able to register up to three food

items with Gaby Corella as first come, first served basis. \$30 registration fee before October 9th and \$50 after this date. Please provide a brief description of your food items. No duplicate items will be allowed. Food Booths will begin selling after 11:00 am. Your club might be penalized if you don't follow the rules. A form to be fill will

be sent to you after registering your food booth.

**EVENTS:** Make sure ALL your Pathfinders are involved in the activities.

#### **EVENTS WITH POINTS:**

**BOOTH/HONOR DISPLAY** 

**CLUB RESPONSIBILITIES/ BOOTH DISPLAY:** Booth set-up must be completed by 7:50 a.m.

- Sign-up for 1 honor (if the club is too small, two clubs can join to present 1 honor)
- Bring all materials needed to teach
- Bring special guest or area expert to teach honor (if applicable)
- Set up an Honors Booth (with canopy, tables and 25 chairs for participants)
- Bring and sign the honor sheet for participants (club directors will be responsible for purchasing the patches for their respective clubs later in the year)

**SUPERVISION**: Please keep your Pathfinders and younger children under your supervision at ALL times.

**CLEAN UP**: Each club must leave the activity area clean. This includes food booth areas. Bring trash bags, a rake or broom to tidy up.

SPECIAL ACCOMMODATIONS: For traveling clubs, lodging at local churches can be arranged. Contact Conference Office – Gaby Corella for more information.

**UNIFORM:** Pathfinders will wear uniform class B (Class A uniform is only required for Pathfinders participating in the opening ceremony)

**REGISTRATION DEADLINE:** October 15, 2025, before 3 p.m. The Conference office will not accept registrations after this date. However, registrations will be accepted at the Fair check-in booth at the increased fee indicated above.

#### HONORS BOOTH OPTIONS

#### **Arizona Pathfinder Honors Day- Presentation Guidelines**

During the Arizona Pathfinder Honors Day, each Pathfinder Club will be responsible for presenting an honor of their choice within a one-hour time frame. The primary objective of these sessions is **not** to complete the honor in its entirety, but rather to introduce participants to the subject, engage them in as many requirements as can reasonably be covered within the allotted time, and inspire further exploration.

Presenters are encouraged to:

- Provide a clear overview of the honor and highlight its significance.
- Actively engage attendees in hands-on activities or discussions that fulfill selected requirements.
- Reserve adequate time for participant questions, clarifications, and group interaction.
- Motivate and challenge Pathfinders to continue working toward the completion of the honor once they return to their home clubs.

In some instances, the instructor may also need to guide participants on **how** to complete the remaining requirements independently, offering practical advice, recommended resources, or step-by-step approaches.

The goal of each presentation is to create an inspiring and educational experience that equips Pathfinders with both the knowledge and motivation to fully complete the honor.
